

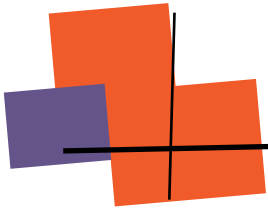


Free Clinic of Southwest Washington Annual Report Fiscal Year 2020—21

Adapting for Success

While 2020-2021 brought new and unprecedented challenges, it was also a hallmark year as the Free Clinic of Southwest Washington celebrated 30 years of providing free, compassionate, quality health care for the uninsured in Clark County. We adapted to the COVID pandemic to ensure the health and safety of our staff, volunteers, and patients by implementing telemedicine appointments, an appointment-based clinic operating model, and adopting our first-ever electronic appointment and medical record system. This has greatly enhanced the care we provide, and we are excited to share the positive effects of these changes with our patients.



The past year has truly demonstrated the value of our community partnerships. We are extremely grateful for the ongoing support of our donors, grantors, and wonderful collaborators, which includes Vancouver Public Schools, Clark County Food Bank, The Community Foundation for Southwest Washington, Clark County Public Health, PeaceHealth, Kaiser Permanente, Providence, Legacy, Vancouver Clinic, local medical providers and dentists, and our partner safety net clinics. 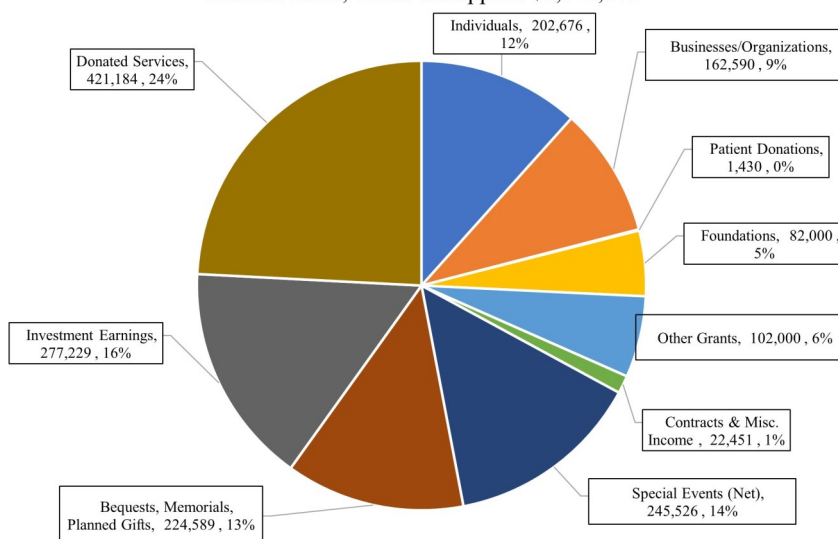

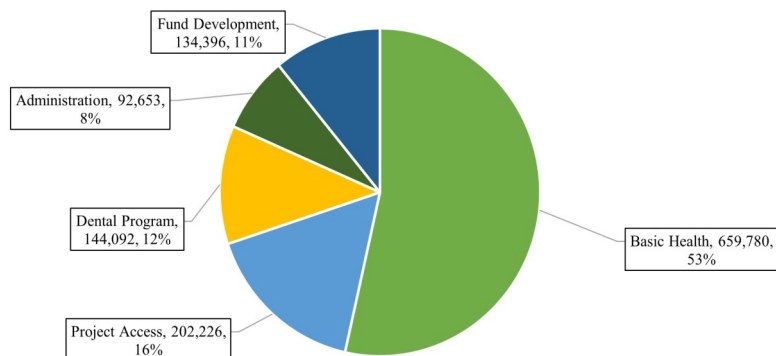
