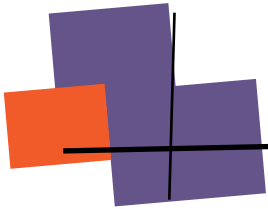

Planning for the Future

The Free Clinic successfully navigated another year of COVID all while continuing to provide high-quality care to our patients. We switched from a walk in-urgent care to an appointment-based model in 2020 and adopted an electronic health record system; our staff and volunteers have been quick to adapt and utilize these changes to improve the care we offer. Some exciting developments during this year included hiring a full-time Community Health Worker, upgrading our medical equipment, hiring a contract dentist to staff a minimum of two dental clinics each month, and administering over 1,200 COVID vaccines.

Our hope is to build on the momentum of the previous year to find sustainable and creative ways to expand our services and best meet the needs of our patients, long-term. This includes shaping the clinic into a strong primary care home, regularly evolving to best serve our patients, creating an efficient and well-functioning space, and continuing to support our diverse, passionate, and skilled, board members, volunteers, and staff.

The work we've accomplished, and plan to accomplish in the years ahead, wouldn't be possible without our wonderful, volunteers, staff, donors, and community partners. We are truly appreciative of all the support we receive from our community. This includes dozens of partner agencies who donate specialty care, financially support our efforts, or raise awareness about our services. Our volunteer providers, nurses, clinic assistants, interpreters, work alongside our staff to fulfill our mission everyday of providing free, compassionate, quality health care for the uninsured. Together, we're able to provide over 4,000 patient encounters every year and we look forward to another year serving our Clark County community!

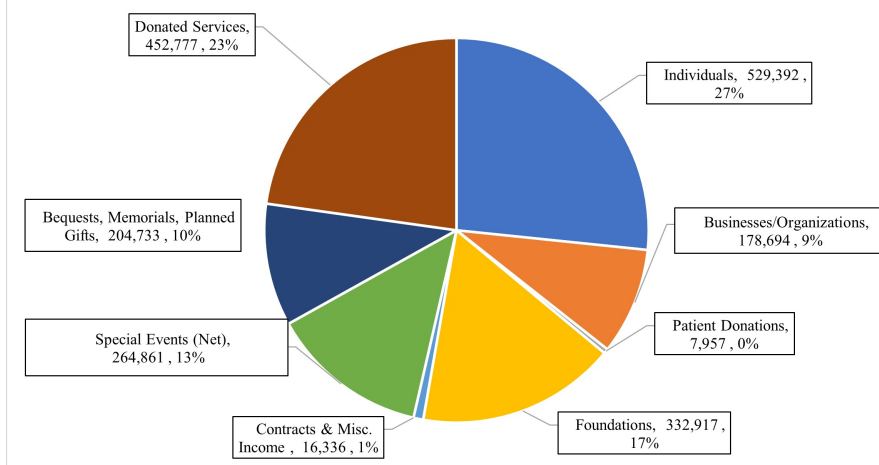

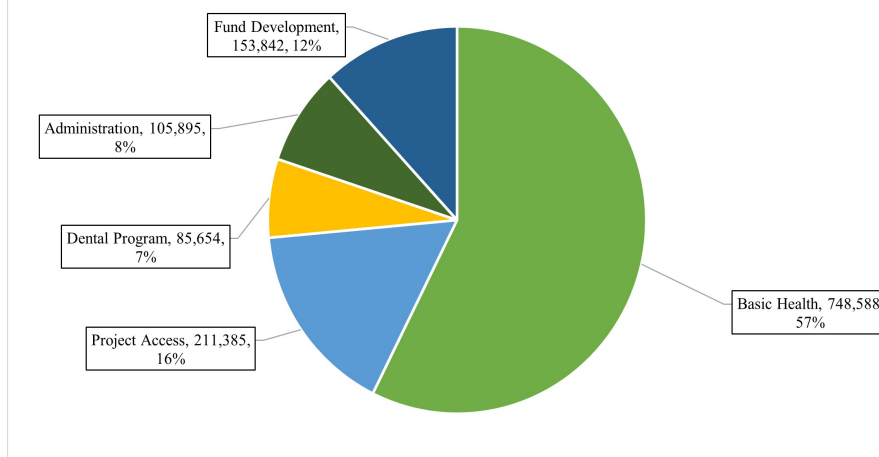

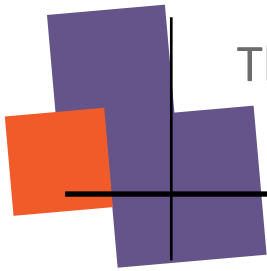
