<u>Position:</u> Community Health Worker

Free Clinic of Southwest Washington

Supervisor: Medical Program Manager

Job Classification: Regular Employee; Non-Exempt

Hours of Work: Monday through Friday, including some evenings

<u>Position Summary:</u> The Community Health Worker (CHW) is member of the multi-disciplinary

healthcare delivery team at the Free Clinic of Southwest Washington (FCSWW). The CHW will be fluent in Spanish and either be a member of, or have a close relationship with, the community the Free Clinic serves.

The CHW serves as a liaison and a healthcare advocate for the community and the FCSWW. The CHW is a bridge between the

community and the FCSWW and its community partners – all of whom are invested in providing the community with access to quality health

care, healthcare education and community safety net services.

Duties & Responsibilities:

1. Serve as the team leader for the Self-Management Education Program.

- 2. Assess individual patients with chronic disease, using motivational interviewing techniques, create individual patient-centered care plans.
- 3. Partner with the FCSWW medical care team in presenting culturally appropriate chronic disease education and other health promotion materials.
- 4. Establish trusting relationships with patients and their families while providing support and encouragement for their patient-centered care plan.
- 5. Advocate for needs of individuals with chronic conditions including assisting individuals with specific non-medical needs that affect health and access to care.
- 6. Enhance health care quality by aiding communication between provider and patient to clarify cultural practices.
- 7. Provide best practices in communicating with patients including coordination of patient appointments, services and follow up via phone calls, texts, home visits and community visits.
- 8. Convene team meetings, attend regular staff meetings, trainings, community meetings, conferences and other meetings as requested.
- Serve as a resource for patients with questions and concerns about vaccine safety.
- 10. Other duties as assigned.

Qualifications:

Must be fluent in Spanish and English – speaking, reading and writing Successful completion of CHW training program or equivalent experience Minimum of 3-years experience in health, social or community services
