VOLUNTEERS: THE HEART OF THE FREE CLINIC

SANDY DANG, DENTAL CLINIC SPECIALIST



Sandy Dang is a dynamo of energetic volunteerism. She has volunteered over 500 hours with the Free Clinic since coming to us last summer. She's been seen working as a dental assistant or clinic specialist in the dental van almost every day.

Sandy is a sophomore studying biology at Washington State University, Vancouver.

It wasn't until she worked at the Free Clinic that she realized she wants to be an oral surgeon. She has found the Free Clinic to be an excellent environment for learning.

"The dentists who volunteer at the Free Clinic are all so helpful and willing to teach," says Sandy. She is fascinated by the problem solving that is done to help each individual patient receive the care they need. She found she was especially drawn to the field of oral surgery. Her admission that she "likes the gore" seems contradictory to her diminutive frame and soft-spoken demeanor, but she adds that she knows the specialty will allow her to make a difference in people's lives.

Sandy will take her Dental Admission Test and begin applying for dental school soon. She says the volunteer dentists at the Free Clinic are generous in providing information and support in guiding her through the complex application process.

"Even when I get through dental school, I will come back here and volunteer," Sandy says. "Everyone here is really nice, even when you first start and you don't know very much. The welcoming environment makes me want to keep coming back."

AMANDA WASHINGTON, MEDICAL CLINIC SPECIALIST

When Amanda Washington was 16 years old, a teacher recommended volunteering at the Free Clinic as part of a class requirement. That was September, 2006, and she's been at the Free Clinic almost every week since.

Amanda has logged over 1,500 volunteer hours. She works as the Clinic Specialist on Tuesday and Thursday evenings, directing the flow between patients and providers, connecting patients with community resources, and processing paperwork, such as referrals for lab work and specialty care.

"I've grown up at the Free Clinic. It's like a second family, because so many of the doctors, nurses and others have volunteered here for a long time, too," Amanda said. She has always known she wanted to study medicine, but the Free Clinic has made her aware that not everyone has the resources to access health care. Her experience has created a desire to one day participate in medical mission trips, helping to care for people in other countries.



Amanda will leave the Free Clinic this fall. She has been accepted to the medical program at Le Moyne College, in Syracuse, New York. She will go into family medicine, to become a physician's assistant (P.A.).

"It will be so strange not to come to the Clinic every Tuesday and Thursday night, but I've been influenced by this experience so much, I can see myself coming back and volunteering as a P.A.," she said. We, here at the Free Clinic, are counting on it.

THE NEED FOR COMPASSIONATE, QUALITY CARE CONTINUES TO GROW



The Free Clinic of Southwest Washington continues to grow, and now provides more than 11,345 medical, dental, vision, immunization and diabetes visits annually and coordinates specialty and dental care in the community for an additional 560 patients each year.



The Free Clinic is so fortunate to have a dedicated and loyal group of volunteers who are making a difference in the lives of our patients. Quality health care for the uninsured is made possible due to the 600 volunteer physicians, nurses, dentists, pharmacists and other health care providers and non-clinical volunteers who continuously give of their time and resources. An additional 300 specialists and dentists in the community also provide care for Free Clinic patients.

Our extraordinary volunteers are dedicated to serving a vulnerable population that is unable to access health care when needed. As the Free Clinic continues to care for those in need, we also recognize there are many changes coming in the health care and insurance environment. A major health care reform bill – the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act – was signed into law in 2010. This new law is a combination of reforms to the private health insurance market, and a plan to extend coverage to millions of Americans in 2014. Because you are an important partner in our work at the Free Clinic, we want to assure you that we are keeping abreast of these changes and will continue to pursue our goal of providing quality health care at no cost for uninsured children and adults.

By all appearances, the local community will still have a tremendous need for the Free Clinic when insurance reforms go into effect. It is estimated that by 2019, there will be as many as 23 million individuals in the United States still uninsured. This group is representative of the patients our Free Clinic has been serving since 1990.

Two years ago our Board of Directors appointed a committee to monitor these changes in health care reform, and to stay abreast of options for the Free Clinic, as the future comes into view. We will update you in our newsletters and welcome your feedback and comments. We are also updating our Free Clinic website – www.freeclinics.org – and soon you will be able to access health care reform updates there.

Along with our team of volunteers at the Free Clinic, and our partners in the community, we will stay the course providing compassionate care for those in need – always! We appreciate your continued support and involvement in meeting the needs of the uninsured. We are truly grateful for all you do for our Clinic, and we look forward to a strong, continuing partnership.

DR. CHARLES PLAMP, M.D.

When an uninsured patient needs more than an urgent care visit can provide, they are often referred to the Free Clinic's Project Access program. The staff and volunteers in Project Access connect patients with one or more of about 300 specialists in the community who have committed to providing free care to a specific number of qualifying uninsured patients each year.



One of those specialists is Dr. Charles Plamp, who provides nephrology services at The Vancouver Clinic. A nephrologist is a physician who specializes in kidney disease. Dr. Plamp has been a volunteer at the Free Clinic for over a decade. He and his partners began seeing uninsured nephrology patients at The Vancouver Clinic when the Project Access program began

Dr. Plamp believes the patient, primarily, but also the local health systems, benefit greatly from the free care that is provided by Project Access specialists in the community. "A patient with kidney disease who doesn't have access to care will end up in the E.R. with acute illness, at a higher cost than a patient who has received planned treatment," he said. For example, there are two patients currently on dialysis that began their care through Project Access.

"It is much better to offer planned treatment than to respond to an emergency. Patients who start dialysis without pre-dialysis care have much higher mortality rates than those who have been cared for proactively. When a patient comes to us from Project Access, we can prepare them for dialysis, and have much better outcomes."

THANK YOU, PROJECT ACCESS VOLUNTEER PROVIDERS

Project Access is a Free Clinic program developed to coordinate donated specialty and hospital services for low-income, uninsured people. Over 300 specialists and the two hospitals in Clark County participate in Project Access, giving free care to a pre-determined number of patients each year.

Four employees, and multiple volunteers at the Free Clinic, devote their time to screening, processing, and guiding referred patients through the steps toward free specialty care.

Following in the footsteps of the original Project Access medical services model, the program has expanded to include dental care. In 2012, a 3-year oral health grant was awarded to the Free Clinic from Kaiser Permanente, to integrate dentists into the Project Access program. Dentists in the community pledge a certain amount of free care for qualified patients and project access staff coordinate the care and services. Currently, 20 dentists provide free care to uninsured patients.

We need you, in order to provide access to free medical and dental services. Donations are vital.
